
It is a less invasive technique with minor associated complications.



The use of small introducers facilitates the cannulation of difficult to access veins and deeper veins.



There is a higher success rate in cannulation as it allows for a more precise puncture and easier guidewire insertion.



Fewer puncture attempts - minimises the risk of loss of venous capital integrity



Total procedure time similar to the Microseldinger Technique, but includes an additional step.
