


# What benefits does the proper **application of care** during the Golden Hour have?



Increased admission temperature is observed. The number of babies with a temperature of 36.5°C - 37.4°C also increases. Neonatal complications due to hypothermia are reduced.



Significant reduction in the time of arrival to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) after birth



Improvement in the administration time of surfactant



Improvement in the onset time of glucose and amino acid infusion



Reduction in the administration time of antibiotics



Decrease in the incidence of intraventricular hemorrhage, hypoglycemia, chronic lung disease, and retinopathy of prematurity



Early placement of umbilical catheters
