

Protocol A cleaning procedure: most diligent group⁵:

- 1. Supplies needed:
- Gauze pad
- Sterile water
- Enteral syringe 3 or 6 ml
- ENFit™ connector cleaning brush (commercial ENFit™ cleaning brush and toothbrush with firm bristles)
- 2. Perform hand hygiene.
- 3. Open the ENFit™ connector and clean the plug with a sterile gauze pad soaked in water.
- 4. Plug the lumen of the ENFit™ connector with a cotton tip to prevent residue from entering the tube during flushing.
- 5. Rinse the ENFit™ connector groove with 2-3 ml sterile water in a pulsating motion.
- 6. Remove the remaining water from the groove.
- 7. Remove the cotton from the lumen of the connector.
- 8. With a brush dipped in sterile water, clean the grooves and the bottom of the connector with a vigorous rotary motion for 10-15 seconds.
- 9. Rinse the brush in sterile water.
- 10. Close the connector lumen with cotton.
- 11. Rinse the groove with 2-3 ml sterile water in the same pulsating motion.
- 12. Remove the cotton from the connector lumen.
- 13. Replace the brush dipped in sterile water and clean with the same vigorous rotary motion.
- 14. If visible residues remain, repeat the operation until the residues disappear.
- 15. Remove excess water from the groove and plug.
- 16. Rinse the brush in sterile water.
- 17. Dry the ENFit™ connector by gently tapping with a cloth and allow to air dry.
